



▲ Manager's Comment

The global financial markets have continued the relatively positive momentum seen in the last two months of the previous year. Resilient economic data and persistent inflation have led to expectations of delayed interest rate cuts by the Federal Reserve. As a result, US bond yields have experienced fluctuations to the upside. At the same time, with increasing expectations of a soft landing and influx of funds, global credit spreads have continued to tighten. Looking ahead, as the starting point for interest rate cuts approaches, US bond yields may gradually fluctuate downward. The current valuation levels make the odds of betting on credit spread compression less favorable. It is important to be cautious of risks such as commercial real estate, private credit, the US presidential election, and weakening corporate profits. The portfolio continues to follow a short duration strategy, maintaining an average duration of around 2 years. It will continue to optimize short duration positions to obtain relatively certain high yield returns. Additionally, the portfolio will actively capture investment and trading opportunities in the primary and secondary markets of medium to long-term bonds.
