▲ Manager's Comment

In August, the financial markets experienced high volatility. In the first half of the month, strong economic data from the United States and rising US bond yields, with the 10-year yield reaching its highest point since 2008, set the tone. Against the backdrop of the Federal Reserve Chairman Powell emphasizing their commitment to combat inflation and the delay in interest rate cuts, risk sentiment was somewhat subdued. However, there was some recovery towards the end of the month. The US economy showed clearer signs of strength compared to China and Europe, with the US dollar and energy outperforming stocks and bonds. In the credit bond market, there was initial suppression followed by a rebound. Most investment-grade bonds maintained relatively stable credit spreads. However, the continuous decline in sales and further default risks for Chinese companies led to a continued decline in the Chinese real estate sector. The fund primarily maintained a higher hedging ratio against interest rates throughout most of the month, while appropriately increasing duration towards the end of the month. It reduced exposure to the financial industry and Europe, and increased allocation to US and corporate bonds.
